<p>Brief Background of the Project:</p> <p>UNHCR In the Russian Federation provides assistance to refugees, asylum-seeker, stateless persons (all hereafter referred as Persons of Concern, PoC), primarily in Moscow, Moscow region and St. Petersburg, but also in selected regions of Russia. Assistance is provided through Partner organizations, primarily non-governmental organizations.</p> <p>Currently the number of PoC in the Russian Federation comes to the following figures (MoI update as of end 2017):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Refugees and temporary asylum holders officially registered with the MoI: 126 034 persons • Asylum-seekers registered with the MoI: 14 086 persons • Stateless persons with temporary residence permit and residence permit registered with the MoI: 9 784 persons <p>1 478 PoCs are registered with UNHCR as of 31 July 2018/ Of them some 850 persons are of concern to UNHCR for medical assistance. An estimated 50% of them regularly use medical services of the partners.</p> <p>UNHCR helps PoC who do not have temporary asylum or refugee status or cannot access the refugee status determination procedure and stay without access to the state medical insurance. This call for Proposals is open to competent NGOs in Moscow and Moscow region and St. Petersburg that may be interested in providing medical support to PoC of concern to UNHCR and to a limited extent in the regions of the Russian Federation hosting PoC in accordance with the detailed Terms of Reference listed in this Call for Proposals.</p>
