Assistance is provided through Partner Organizations, primarily non-governmental organizations.</p> <p>Currently the number of PoCs in the Russian Federation comes to the following figures (Mol update as of end 2017):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Refugees and temporary asylum holders officially registered with the Mol: 126 034 persons • Asylum-seekers registered with the Mol: 14 086 persons • Stateless persons with temporary residence permit and residence permit registered with the Mol: 9 784 persons <p>1 478 PoCs are registered with UNHCR as of 31 July 2018.</p> <p>PoCs require social support with psycho-social counselling, community development, access to shelter, job-placement and access to social benefits, enrolment in local schools, Russian language classes as well as psychological support and in some cases, material assistance. UNHCR opens this Call for Proposal for competent NGOs in Moscow, St. Petersburg and other regions of Russia that may be interested in providing indicated support to PoCs to UNHCR in accordance with the detailed Terms of Reference listed in this Call for Proposals.</p>
